Barbara Lynn Freedy, 65, died Friday, June 7, 2024 in Greensboro.

Barbara L. Freedy was born April 5, 1959 in Columbus, OH. She graduated from Upper Arlington High School and obtained undergraduate (Phi Beta Kappa) and law degrees from The Ohio State University. After practicing health care law for the West Virginia Attorney General Office (Charleston, WV) she moved to Durham, North Carolina in 1989. Barbara earned a Masters Degree in Health Administration (MHA) from Duke University in 1991. Thereafter she was employed for 27 years at Forsyth Memorial Hospital/Novant Health in Winston Salem, NC. She retired as Director of Certificate of Need (CON) Operations in 2018.

Barb was introduced to her future husband on a blind date in January 1990 while they both were active at Duke University. She and Doug were married in the Duke Chapel on September 1, 1991, and moved to Greensboro, NC. Their son, Cameron, was born in 1993.
